When to Apply Varnish

Using full eggs?

- ▶ after last dye
- ▶ before emptying / blowing eggs

Using empty eggshells?

- ▶ after last dye

Using Varnish

- ▶ requires hand cleaner
- ▶ use disposable gloves
- ▶ use plastic bag



Types of Varnish

- ▶ Brand Name: Cabot
- ▶ Product Name: Gloss polyurethane
- ▶ Description: oil based
hard and durable finish



Types of Varnish

- ▶ Brand Name: Delta Ceramics
- ▶ Product Name: Gloss varnish
- ▶ Description: durable, moisture-resistant; will not leave brush marks, dries in minutes and guards against scratches



Types of Varnish

- ▶ Brand Name: EnviroTex
- ▶ Product Name: Epoxy pour-on
- ▶ Description: thick, high gloss finish



Types of Varnish

- ▶ Brand Name: Golden
- ▶ Product Name: Hard MSA topcoat
- ▶ Description: formerly Hard MSA varnish non-removable, resistance to ultraviolet radiation; can be used over acrylic, oil, and alkyd



Types of Varnish

- ▶ Brand Name: KBS Coatings
- ▶ Product Name: Clear coat Diamond
- ▶ Description: No yellowing, cracking or peeling



Types of Varnish

- ▶ Brand Name: Liquitex
- ▶ Product Name: High gloss varnish
- ▶ Description:
gloss acrylic, permanent, protects against UV damage; dries clear; use on all acrylic surfaces; non-yellowing, water-resistant when dry



Types of Varnish

- ▶ Brand Name: Minwax
- ▶ Product Name: Clear polyurethane
- ▶ Description: fast drying, durable, clear finish



Types of Varnish

- ▶ Brand Name: Sign Painters
- ▶ Product Name: 1-Shot
- ▶ Description: fast drying UV resistant clear topcoat; prevents colors from fading and provides mild abrasion resistance

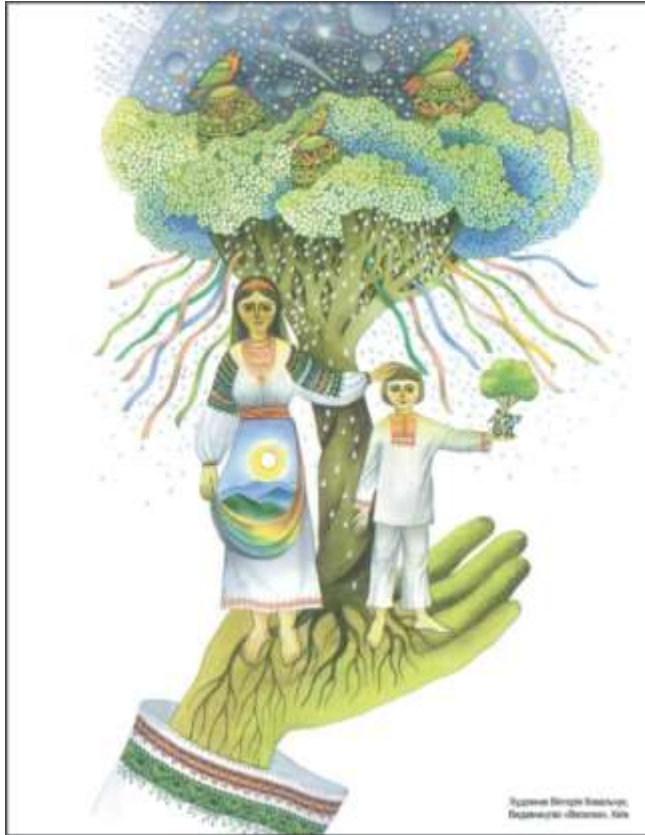


Types of Varnish

- ▶ Brand Name: Stevenson
- ▶ Product Name: Satin Varnish / Medium
- ▶ Description: solvent- based; hard and durable finish



Protect the Environment



- ▶ use animal fat
- ▶ use vegetable oil

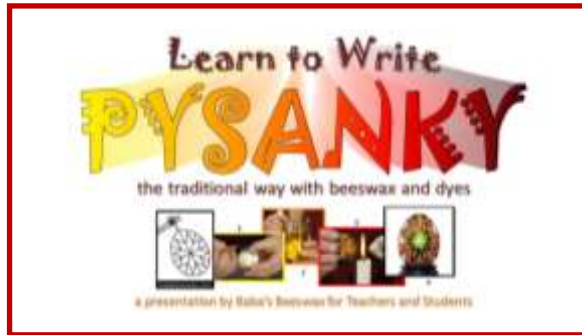
