

Background

In the Workshop students will use the language of symbolism in color and design to create a story on an egg. Symbols are repeated to create a design. This Lesson Plan introduces a geometric star, with eight points, which is one of the oldest traditional Ukrainian designs. It is called a "star rosette". The variety of interpretation of the star rosette has no limits.

The shaded areas in the following examples represent terms which are used in this Lesson Plan and during the Workshop.



Instructions

The Ukrainian name for these unique eggs is derived from a Ukrainian word which means "to write". Students can practice **writing** the star rosette design with pencil and paper. Do not use colored pencils or crayons. This task mimics the specialized tools and technique used in the Workshop. The use of colour will be covered in the Workshop.
